Margaret Kimberley is Editor and Senior Columnist at *Black Agenda Report*. She is a regular guest on radio and internet talk shows and has appeared on *Al Jazeera English*, *RT*, *WBAI*, *KPFK*, *Presstv Iran*, and *Govorit Moskva* (Moscow Voice Radio).

Ms. Kimberley serves on the Administrative Committee of the United National Antiwar Coalition (UNAC), the Coordinating Committee of Black Alliance for Peace and the Advisory Board of ExposeFacts.org.

She is writing a book about racism and the American presidency. She is a graduate of Williams College and lives in New York City.

Dan Kovalik is a human rights, labor rights lawyer and peace activist. He works as the Associate General Counsel of the United

Steelworkers Union and teaches International Human Rights at the University of Pittsburgh School of Law.

Kovalik's advocacy for human rights and social justice focuses mainly on Latin America. The *Christian Science Monitor* named him "one of the most prominent defenders of Colombian workers in the United States." In a radio interview with Matt Dwyer about Venezuela's 2013 elections, Kovalik called the Bolivarian Revolution, "the most benevolent revolution in history." Recently, he traveled to Nicaragua to support the Sandinista government in its struggle against an attempted coup.

Kovalik has contributed articles to: *TeleSur*, *CounterPunch*, and *Huffington Post*. He is the author of: *The Plot to Attack Iran* and *the Plot to Scapegoat Russia*.
